Gender and Sex Determinants of Cardiovascular Disease

The GENESIS CVD/ICE team (Cardiovascular Disease Inter-Disciplinary Capacity Enhancement Team), is funded by CIHR and the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada. A pan-Canadian group of investigators comprising leaders from a diverse range of disciplines, including molecular genetics, health services and outcome research, epidemiology and public health is recruiting:

- 2 (two) PhD and/or Post-Doctoral students and/or Master students
- 1 (one) young investigator (MD or PhD)
- Candidates from all disciplines are welcome to this competition

The selected applicants, under the supervision of a GENESIS Team Mentor, will be involved in research projects on the topic of gender/sex and cardiovascular disease. The successful applicants will engage in the:

Design and Analysis write-up, the publication and presentation of results of projects under one of the following themes:

1. Sex and Gender Determinants of development, acquisition and modification of CVD Risk Factors across the lifespan
2. Sex and Gender Differences in manifestation of Coronary Disease (diagnosis, manifestations, outcomes)
3. Sex and Gender Differences in Efficacy, Effectiveness of interventions

In addition, they will be given the opportunity to take on leadership roles, such as writing grants, heading videoconferences and participating in GENESIS committee meetings.

Deadline: **Monday October 1 2007, 4pm EST**
Notification: Applicants will be notified of the results of the competition by **Monday October 15th 2007**
Location: Opportunity to work in various cities within Canada
Duration: The selected scholars may be fully supported for at least 2 years at the CIHR level
Eligibility: Supervisor and/or co-supervisor must be a GENESIS Investigator*
